Dr. Burgess is a nationally and internationally recognized and advanced technology in non-invasive aesthetic procedures. She has written, lectured and trained physicians extensively on her patented technique (U.S. Patent No. 7,637,900 and 8,038,665,B2) of soft tissue enhancement of injectables fillers and neuromodulators injection techniques before annual conferences in Dermatology and Facial Plastic Surgery. She is also a clinical research investigator, consultant, advisor, and key opinion leader serving on the advisory boards to Allergan, Inc. (Botox® and Juvederm®), Galderma (Restylane®/Dysport®/Sculptra®), Johnson & Johnson (RoC®, Aveeno®), Merz Aesthetics (Radiesse®/Xeomin®/Belotero®) and the co-founder of Biocosmetic Research Labs (Black Opal Skin Care and Color Cosmetics®). She is the author of Cosmetic Dermatology, a peer review textbook published by Springer Verlag as well as published articles in numerous scientific peer review textbooks and journals, to include Dermatologic Surgery, Journal of Drugs in Dermatology, Aesthetic Plastic Surgery, Cosmetic Dermatology, Cutis, Journal of the American Academy of Dermatology and is the Associate Editor of the Journal of Cosmetic Dermatology.
