

Dr. Pamela Brewer received the Distinguished Alumna Award from New York University Silver School of Social Work (2016) for her pioneering efforts in the creation and distribution of mental health/relationship awareness/health programming. ((MyNDTALK with Dr. Pamela Brewer is a relationship/mental health program originated by Dr. Brewer in 1995.)

Pamela Brewer earned her MSW in Clinical Social Work from New York University, New York in 1984 where she graduated with honors as the first African American and first Social Work Student in the history of the University to be selected to deliver the Student Address at the 1984 graduation ceremonies attended by 10,000+ persons. Her significant accomplishments were covered by local news media.

Brewer established her private practice in 1984 – and remains in private practice today.

Brewer went on to receive her Ph.D. in Social Psychology from the Union Institute and University in Cincinnati, Ohio in 1992. Currently, Brewer is a Board Certified Licensed Clinical Social Worker with over thirty years of postgraduate clinical experience. Brewer is licensed at the highest clinical social work level in Maryland, Washington, DC, Virginia, and Alabama and has achieved the lifetime status of Diplomat in Clinical Social Work.

Brewer has written and produced for television and radio, published many articles and made appearances on local radio programs and local and national television programs.

MyNDTALK with Dr. Pamela Brewer is a relationship/mental health program that initially originated in 1995 as a weekly relationship and mental health program from the studios of Sister Pacifica Station, WPFW 89.3 FM in the Washington, DC Tri-State AREA. MyNDTALK became available nationally via the PACIFICA NETWORK to its sister stations and affiliates in @ 2006. In 2014, MyNDTALK transitioned to a daily one-hour podcast airing on several platforms including MyNDTALK.org.

Her **teaching/field instruction experiences** include Brooklyn College Women's Center - Brooklyn, New York; University of Maryland School of Social Work /Law Clinic - Baltimore, Maryland and George Mason University School of Social work - Fairfax, Virginia.
