- 2. Must be a United States Citizen or have permanent resident status

- 1. Letter of request for consideration to include:
 - Personal Statement about yourself
 - Why you are studying to be a dentist
 - What it means to you to be a female in dentistry
 - Your anticipated plans/goals for after dental school
- 2. Curriculum vitae
- 3. Copy of dental school transcript through Fall 2024
- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendation from dental school faculty (please have faculty email recommendations directly to our email)
